Say with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord." Believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead. Then you will be saved. - Romans 10:9


Scripture says, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." - Romans 10:13

But God is faithful and fair. If we confess our sins, he will forgive our sins. He will forgive every wrong thing we have done. He will make us pure. - 1 John 1:9

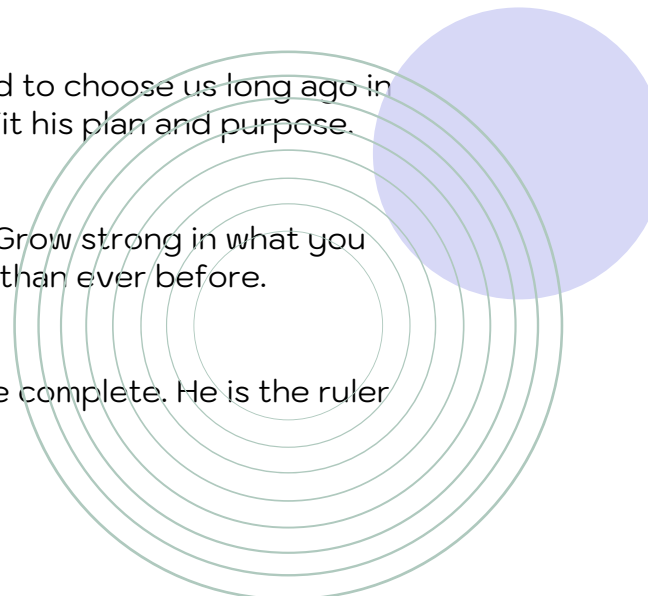
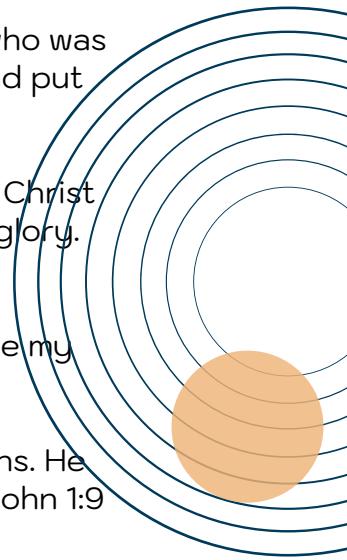

I can do all this by the power of Christ. He gives me strength. - Philippians 4:13

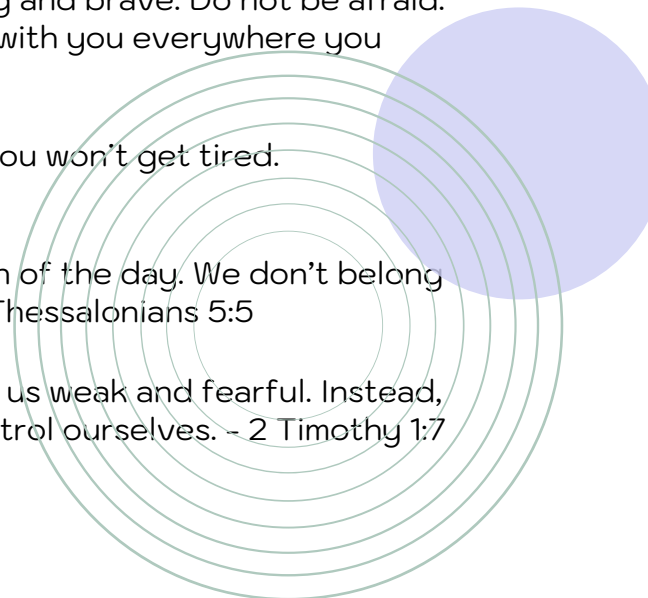
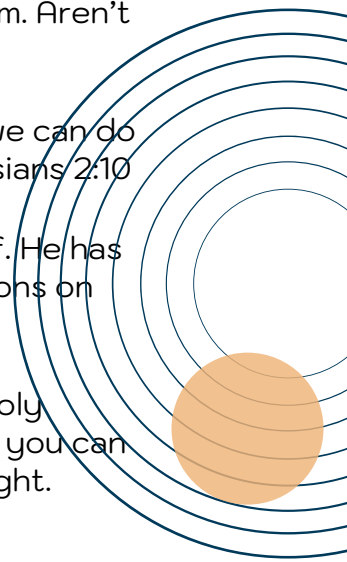
Teach them to obey everything I have commanded you. And you can be sure that I am always with you, to the very end." - Matthew 28:20

You have been born again by means of the living word of God. His word lasts forever. You were not born again from a seed that will die. You were born from a seed that can't die. - 1 Peter 1:23

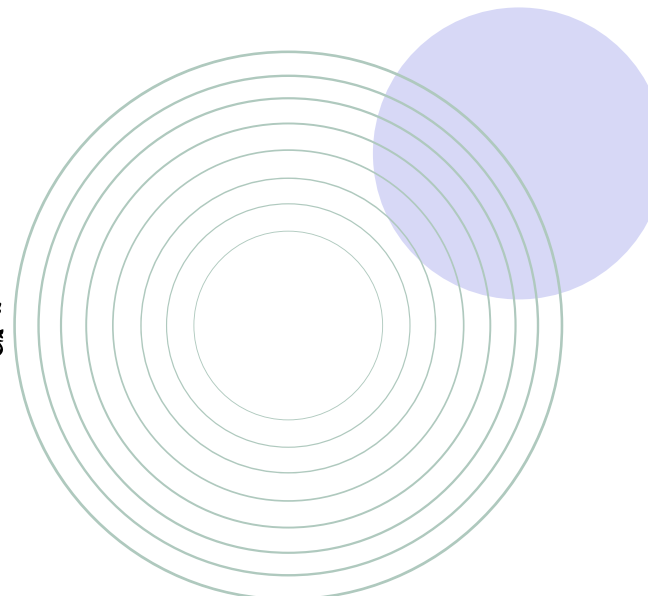
Christ is your life. When he appears again, you also will appear with him in heaven's glory. - Colossians 3:4
